

Gov. Scott Walker's Office issues statement on Tuesday's D.C. Court of Appeals ruling:

"Today's ruling shows how irresponsible it is to pass a law without knowing what is in it and what its impact will be on hard-working Americans. The federal government's one-size-fits-all approach is unsustainable, and the federal government's disastrous rollout and inept implementation of their own law is putting over 130,000 Wisconsinites at risk. Governor Walker continually opposed the Affordable Care Act and worked to move forward with a uniquely Wisconsin solution. This is exactly why Governor Walker's reforms make sense for Wisconsin and why he choose not to take the federal government's Medicaid expansion because Governor Walker's reforms protect Wisconsin taxpayers and those living in poverty from continued uncertainty from the federal government.

Given that the court did not issue an injunction, it appears there is no immediate impact on Wisconsin consumers."
