\$80.1 million

The proposed behavioral health hospital will have an estimated total impact on income of nearly **\$80.1 million** throughout all businesses and industries for Milwaukee-West Allis, Wisconsin.*

For every \$1 of income generated by the proposed behavioral health hospital, another estimated \$0.35 is generated in other businesses and industries.

250-300 jobs

The proposed behavioral health hospital will create over **250-300 jobs** including physicians, nurses, clinicians, mental health technicians and support staff.

\$11.3 million

Annually, the proposed behavioral health hospital will generate more than an estimated **\$11.3 million** in direct total income paid to hospital employees.

\$28.8 million

The construction and operation of the proposed behavioral health hospital will boost personal consumption expenditures by more than an estimated \$28.8 million.

\$46.4 million

The proposed behavioral health hospital will contribute an estimated **\$46.4 million** to the Gross Area Product (GAP) to the region.
